

MINUTES OF SPECIAL CALLED CITY COUNCIL MEETING AUGUST 30, 2018

1. **Call to order.** Meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M. by Mayor Pro Tem Jim Mastergeorge.
2. **Invocation.** Brenton Lane provided the Invocation.
3. **Roll Call.** Councilmembers present: Brenton Lane, Jim Mastergeorge, Steve Janics, and Steven Tindell. Mayor Bert Echterling, and Councilmembers Jeremy Stivener Jimmy Rogers were absent.
4. **Consider and possible action on Ordinance 2018-011 adopting a budget and making appropriations for the support of the City of Robinson for Fiscal Year 2018-2019.** City Manager Craig Lemin presented this item, and gave a brief overview of the budget summary. Councilmember Steve Janics motioned to approve Ordinance 2018-011 adopting the budget as presented. Mayor Pro Tem Jim Mastergeorge seconded this motion. Voting in favor: Lane, Mastergeorge, Janics, and Tindell. There were no opposing votes and the motion carried by a vote of 4-0.
5. **Consider and possible action on Ordinance 2018-012 adopting tax rate and levying property taxes for 2018.** City Manager Craig Lemin presented this item and provided a brief summary of the proposed tax rate. Councilmember Steven Tindell motioned that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.484500, which is effectively a 6.2 percent increase in the tax rate. Councilmember Brenton Lane seconded this motion. Voting in favor: Lane, Mastergeorge, Janics, and Tindell. There were no opposing votes and the motion carried by a vote of 4-0.
6. **Consider and possible action to ratify the property tax increase reflected by the adoption of the budget which requires raising more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year.** City Manager Craig Lemin presented this item. Councilmember Brenton Lane motioned to ratify the property tax revenue increase reflected in the FY 2018-2019 budget. Councilmember Steve Janics seconded this motion. Voting in favor: Lane, Mastergeorge, Janics, and Tindell. There were no opposing votes and motion carried by a vote of 4-0.
