The City of Robinson is partnering with Animal Birth Control Clinic to offer microchipping Saturday, April 16th from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. at Brookshire's Grocery. The February newsletter covered several city ordinances, including microchipping. This event gives an affordable and convenient opportunity for pets to become compliant with the microchip ordinance.

Microchipping helps ensure your beloved family pet is returned home quick and safe. It also keeps them out of the local animal shelter, avoiding costly fees. The first 10 microchips are free (with your Robinson water bill). Lifetime HomeAgain database registration is included; no fee to later update basic contact data. If you live in the surrounding area, the microchips are \$10. Email with questions animalbirthcontrol@sbcglobal.net.
