Flat Creek Flood Protection Study - Public Meeting


The City of Waco, in conjunction with the cities of Robinson, Hewitt, and Woodway received a Flood Protection Planning grant from the Texas Water Development Board to conduct a study of Flat Creek to develop both short term and long term recommendations for flood damage reduction and flood warning measures. There will be a meeting hosted on Thursday, August 4th, a second in a series of public meetings to present results and receive public input.

Kids 1st Aid Workshop



This is the only first aid course in the US taught and developed exclusively by practicing EMTs, Paramedics and Fire fighters. Kids 1st Aid is a 3-hour workshop based on the top 10 reasons an ambulance is called for a child.

Their first hand experience with children's emergencies has taught them that most parents or caregivers know to call 911...but very often do NOT know what to do during those critical moments until professional help arrives. This workshop will teach you how to respond calmly and with confidence to all the things parents worry about most. The course covers the 10 most common childhood first aid emergencies: CPR, choking, drowning, burns, poisoning, allergies and anaphylaxis, stings and bites, seizures and fever, fractures and bleeding. Plus smart safety education in the home and car to avoid accidents.
