Water/Wastewater Timeline of Projects

Year	Amount	Projects
2013	\$105,000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Replaced water lines on Caron & Donlo Street Added a new pump house at the Hoffmeyer well-site
2014	\$1,713,671	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Replaced water lines on Candyce, Lawndale, Greenbriar, Dean, Dison, Aubrey and Stefka Streets. Replaced sewer mains on Ivan, Ward, and Moonlight. Took the Ivan and Sturgis lift station out of service. Added a new pump house at the Greenbriar well-site along with a SCADA monitoring system. Completed the disinfectant improvement project converting it from free chlorine to chloramines.
2015	\$1,968,007	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Replaced water lines on McLendon Street, Ward (from Hwy 77 to S. Andrews) and on the East side of HWY 77 (from Moonlight Drive to Fidelity Bank). Replaced sewer mains on Hillview and Nelson Street. Added a third booster pump to the Elevated Storage Site on Grieg Drive along with a generator to keep the site operational during power outages. Added a new pump house at the Elizabeth well-site along with SCADA monitoring system. Added a new 250,000-gallon ground storage tank.
2016	\$615,000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rebuilt Lux lift station and installed SCADA monitoring system to 5 lift stations. Leaned nearly 2 feet of settlement out from inside the water plants intake structure. Replaced 2 gates valves, 2 swing check valves, and a 5100 gallon per minute raw water pump at the water plant.
2017	\$1,073,792	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reconditioned of the Micro-Floc Units at the water plant. Installed new membranes at the water plant. Vegetated and grubbed the future location of the next reservoir near the water plant.
Projects Underway	\$818,147	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pipe bursting for Meadowbrook Addition and Fain Estates.
Upcoming Projects		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lyndale lift station abandonment. Sewer line extension to the Flat Creek Inceptor.

No Rate Increase for Water/Wastewater

In 2013, a 5-year water and wastewater rate plan was adopted, which was revised in 2014 & 2015, to fund approximately \$25 million in needed infrastructure improvements in the city. The timeline displayed on the front of the newsletter highlights the different projects completed over the last 5 years and the total cost associated with each year. After an evaluation of the projected revenues, expenses, and bond funds available for water/wastewater projects Craig Lemin, City Manager, has recommended the city waive the increase in rates scheduled for October 1, 2017. This will leave plenty of revenue for current and some future projects. This will also provide the city an opportunity to re-evaluate the timeline and priority of remaining projects and update the rate study.
