Dear Mayor Echterling, Members of the City Council, and Mr. Lemin,

The Texas Legislature enacted the Racial Profiling Law in 2001. There were changes to the Law in 2009, and now again in 2017, with the passing of the Sandra Bland Act, which requires more detailed analysis. Please find the attached Robinson Police Department Racial Profiling Report, which includes a legislatively required Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) Tier I Report for vehicle stops between January 1, 2017, and December 31, 2017. This report was submitted to TCOLE on February 28, 2018.

In addition, a copy of the Robinson Police Department's current Racial Profiling Policy (Biased Based Policing) is included. There are tables that depict comparative data, namely comparing 2016 and 2017 motor vehicle stops to demographics found for the City of Robinson in 2016 from City-Data.com.

It should be noted that all officers of the Robinson Police Department have been instructed in accordance with the Racial Profiling Law. It should also be noted that the Chief of Police has also met the training requirements of the Racial Profiling Law.

Finally, in 2017, the Robinson Police Department received no complaints alleging racial profiling.

This report is respectfully submitted as evidence of the Robinson Police Department's commitment to comply with the Texas Racial Profiling Law.

Certification to This Report 2.132 (Tier 1), Partial Exemption

Article 2.132(b) CCP Law Enforcement Policy on Racial Profiling

Robinson Police Department has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- 1.) clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- 2.) strictly prohibits peace officers employed by the Robinson Police Department from engaging in racial profiling;
- 3.) implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the Robinson Police Department if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the Robinson Police Department has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- 4.) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- 5.) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the Robinson Police Department who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the Robinson Police Department's policy adopted under this article;
- 6.) require collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:

a.) the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;

b.) whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search; and

c.) whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual; and

7.) require the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision(6) to:

a.) the Commission on Law Enforcement; and

b.) the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.
